1. **This show will be held at a new location the new location is Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church, 5005 Northwest Blvd, Plymouth, MN 55442**
2. **Set up is Friday, March 29th beginning at 6pm until 10pm you may enter door A of Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church. Once you are checked in, you may begin setting up. The building will be secured and locked at 10pm.**
3. You may park in front of the Church to unload products and then crafters/vendors will need to park in the designated area.
4. Crafters and Vendors may enter the building on Saturday, March 30th, 2019, beginning at 8:45am through Door A.
5. Crafters/Vendors from the Fall 2018 show will be given first chance at a space when registration and payment are received on or before January 18, 2019. After January 18, 2019, spaces assigned on a first registered/paid – basis. We will consider and try to honor special requests; however, they cannot be guaranteed.
6. We do extensive media advertising. This is our 19th year and we have a record of great attendance averaging 900+ shoppers each show.
7. The facility is a great public venue and is fully handicap accessible.
8. Our spaces fill up quickly and crafters/vendors are strongly encouraged to **BOOK EARLY!**
9. Payments by cash, cashier's check or money order are required for registrations/payments received after March 15th, 2019. Checks will not be accepted after this date. **WE DO NOT ACCEPT CREDIT CARDS.**
10. Checks are cashed approximately twice a month, please plan accordingly. The fee for returned checks is \$25.
11. Cancellations must be received in writing by March 1, 2019, for payments to be refunded. There is a non-refundable \$10.00 cancellation policy.
12. All crafters/vendors are required to secure any necessary license/permits for his or her operations, including any food licenses that may be required to distribute product samples. Sales tax is the responsibility of the crafter (Plymouth sales tax = 7.525%). **Minnesota Laws require that both Profit and Non-Profit Vendors provide a Minnesota Tax ID and a completed ST-19 for each show.**
13. If this is the first time in our show, you must submit pictures of your products and display.
14. If you require accommodation for any special needs, please advise us and we will try to accommodate as much as possible
15. We reserve the right to limit the number of crafters/vendors in any specific category to ensure a broad sampling of items at the event.
16. We reserve the right to ask crafters/vendors to remove items from being sold if we deem inappropriate. We reserve the right to refuse applications at our discretion and without explanation.

Crafters/Vendors retain all responsibility for the protection and security of their own property. While efforts are made to guard against injury, damage or theft, the Maple Grove Women of Today cannot and will not be responsible for any loss, damage, or expense arising out of or from any accident or occurrence at the event causing injury to any person or property.
